

Validation of courses/examinations

Courses and exams taken at other universities can be validated as a substitute for our courses at FAU as long as they are comparable. For a judgement of comparability we need the following pieces of information:

- Syllabus/Structure of the course
- List of literature used in the course
- Information about SWS and ECTS
- Information about the mode of examination
- Completed learning agreement form (available in the International Office).

Please submit these documents personally, by e-mail, fax or mail to Angela Brunner (angela.brunner@fau.de).

Please note that we need official information from the relevant university and that the decision can only be made when all necessary documents have been supplied.

Currently, only learning agreements can be made for the following courses:

- Mikroökonomie (Bachelor)
- Microeconomics for IBS/IES students (Bachelor)
- Game Theory (Master)

For validating coursework taken abroad, please hand in your learning agreement, the original certificate or transcript of records, as well as the completed course validation form of the International Office to your subject advisor.
